# DESCRIPTION OF THE YOUTH EXCHANGE

Digitalization is changing everything from the environment to socio-economic developments all over the world, with the fastest transformation ever witnessed in human history. It is also very important to keep up with this change and to catch up with the new world order. Young people, who are the architects of the future, will either adapt to this digital technology and learn the skills of the new age to have a sustainable future or succumb to threats such as the climate crisis and nature recording, which uncontrolled digitalization is facing the world. At this point, young people are presented with two options; a healthy digital future, or a future where cyber threats, environmental problems, and digital waste occur. At this point, it is very important to raise awareness of young people in the field of digital literacy. Otherwise, a digital society without digital literacy knowledge will cause great harm to both the environment and the individual and will drag the world to the end. According to the European Commission's Digital Skills paper, around 42% of Europeans lack basic digital skills, including 37% of the workforce. Considering all these, the general and specific objectives of our project are as follows; 1. Introducing the concept of "e-waste", which has emerged due to our consumption habits and increasing our commitment to technology, to young people and creating awareness in this field, will make young people conscious of digital pollution, 2. Digital pollution has become one of the biggest problems in our world in recent years. Digital pollution is especially the pollution created by the operation of the internet network. Data traffic circulating between continents is one of the best examples of this. Especially young people, who are the biggest peers of digital technology, make a great contribution to this pollution due to their lack of knowledge in this field.



# **Objectives:**

Digi-(YOU) The project was designed during the design phase, especially considering the goals of the Erasmus+ program and Youth Exchange. At this point, our project is related to these goals as follows;

- 1. With "QUALITY LEARNING FOR ALL", which is one of the EU's 2021-2027 Youth Strategy targets, it is aimed that many young people will reach quality learning and gain the ability to use what they have learned for life, thanks to the training that our project will provide.
- 2. The main objective of the Erasmus+ Program and Youth Exchanges is to open doors for young people to acquire new skills, contribute to their personal development, and be supported in new employment areas. Our project also aims to provide participants with these opportunities in the digital and environmental fields and to enable them to acquire new skills so that they can improve themselves.
- 3. In our project, where sustainable studies will be discussed, the participants will be encouraged to have a say in the developing world by carrying out studies on sustainable growth and to take a more active role in decision-making processes on issues that concern them.
- 4. Among the target groups of Digi-(YOU)th project, there are young people with few opportunities. In this way, participants who do not have access to the opportunity will be supported. In addition, the participants will be informed about new opportunities thanks to the workshops on topics such as EU studies and European opportunities.
- 5. Our project will support intercultural dialogue with 36 participants from 6 different countries. Participants will be allowed to own cultures and get to know new cultures. In this way, the participants will have the experience of working in a multicultural environment.
- 6. Non-formal education techniques will be used in all activities carried out during the project. Through non-formal training techniques, participants will be able to express themselves more actively during the sessions, and they will also give them the chance to develop their skills such as speaking in public, as well as learning non-formal training techniques.
- 7. Beyond these, our project will create an international cooperation network between institutions and create new projects and workspaces. 8. We will actively involve our project partners and participants in all the activities we will do during our project, and we will assign them as well. This way, we will ensure that our partner organizations create a participatory network, not just a partner.

# We will refund only travel tickets that we approved prior purchase!

We kindly ask you to choose the most economical and eco-friendly way of transport (e.g. student fares, low cost airlines, 2nd class trains, etc.).

Also, be aware of your travel cost limitation. We reimburse the travel cost ONLY up to the limit designed for your country.

We will also reimburse only those ticket that will show:

- 1. the currency
- 2. dates of your travel
- 3. places you are traveling from/to and your name (or number of passengers).

It is important to keep all your tickets (also from your local buses and trains).

It is NOT possible to travel by car or taxi!

The travel costs within the budget limit of your country (please see above) will be reimbursed after the youth exchange to the bank account of your sending organisation and only if these 3 conditions are fulfilled:

- 1) You gave all the ORIGINAL tickets to our organization. It's fundamental to bring the invoices or the travel confirmations where is clearly shown the price;
  - 2) You attended the full duration of the youth exchange;
  - 3) You submitted all reports that our organization or EU requested.
    - 4) We need PDF of boarding pass (QR code is not valid)

In case you need visa, please apply for them immediately as we confirm your participation because it may take long time. If you need an invitation letter from us, please let us know.

# INSURANCE, MEDICAL AND SAFETY ADVICES

Please, be aware that it is compulsory for all participants to have travel insurance covering the whole duration of your stay in Spain, including the days of your arrival and departure. Travel insurance cannot be covered by us, but you are obliged to arrange it by yourself when coming to Spain.

Most of the course will be held indoors. Take your medications – it is good to take pills from your country (you know yourself the best so take painkillers, antipyretic, something against cold that works for you.



Please bring your European Health Insurance Card (the blue one) in case of some emergency.

If you have any special needs (allergies, diets, disabilities, disadvantages, etc.), please state them clearly in the Application Form so we can arrange everything in advance and we do not meet the problem of solving your special needs problem after your arrival to the Spain. Also, please take your medication with yourself.
